To request the MDOT OPPPD request WILMAPCO to approve the following TIP amendment and, upon WILMAPCO approval, notify the Federal Highway Administration - Maryland Division of the amendment to the WILMAPCO FY 2025 - FY 2028 TIP.

The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) hereby requests WILMAPCO to amend the FY 2025-2028 WILMAPCO TIP to reflect the following action.

ANALYSIS

Planning and Design for Belvidere Road Improvements — This requested amendment will add \$420,000 in right-of-way funding into the FY 2025-2028 WILMAPCO TIP. The project extends from the intersection of US 40 to the southern limit of the CE055 Bridge replacement project that extends to approximately 500 feet north of Americold's entrance. The project will support existing and continued development of businesses on Belvidere Road and US 40. The total cost of the project is estimated to be \$1,625,000 with construction estimates unidentified. This total cost includes \$1,000,000 in planning and design funds previously programmed in the FY 2023-2026 TIP, the \$420,000 being added, and \$205,000 programmed beyond TIP years. The ROW funds are anticipated to be spent starting in FY 2025 through early 2030.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid. In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2025-2030 Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP) and FY 2022-2025 Maryland STIP.
