The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) hereby amends the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2028 Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to include the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board (BRTB) FY 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and the associated Conformity Determination which was approved by the BRTB on July 22, 2025.

The MDOT has assigned Control #25-21 for this amendment, and the Maryland Statewide Transportation Improvement Program continues to be fiscally constrained. To our Federal Partners:

At its Board meeting on July 22, 2025 the BRTB took several actions. We are sharing the following documents: 2026-2029 Baltimore Region Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), and the associated Conformity Determination of the 2026-2029 TIP and Resilience 2050 and the Appendices, as well as the Self-Certification of the Baltimore regional transportation planning process. All actions were approved by resolution (Resolutions #26-2 and #26-3) of the BRTB.

In the course of developing and approving these documents, the BRTB followed relevant guidance for public involvement, financial constraint and air quality analysis. The Interagency Consultation Group approved the methodology for conducting air quality related analysis, the Technical Committee provided the technical inputs to the travel demand model, and the Cooperative Forecasting Group provides the socioeconomic forecasts. Following a 30-day public review, the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board

received comments and sent a <u>response to those stakeholders</u>, which is incorporated into the documentation for the TIP and Conformity.

At the conclusion of the development and review of the Baltimore region TIP, Conformity Determination, and Self-Certification review, the documents were approved by the Baltimore Regional Transportation Board (BRTB).
