PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT OPPPD, notify the Federal Highway Administration - Maryland Division of this amendment to add a new project to the FY 2025-2028 STIP.

ANALYSIS

CO 456 and CO 454 over Evitts Creek Bridge Replacements (AL4911) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new Allegany County lead project for the replacement of two bridges, CO 456 (Old Mount Pleasant Road) and CO 454 (Mason Road) both over Evitts Creek, and the addition of \$1,925,495 in congressionally directed spending for construction in FY 26 - FY 28 for the project.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2025-2030 Consolidated Transportation Program and FY 2025-2028 Maryland STIP.
