On July 31, 2025, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments Department of Transportation Planning (MWCOG DTP) staff approved the following Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) requested administrative modifications to the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP.

Areawide Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation (T3081) – This requested administrative modification reflects the addition of \$1,000,000 in FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP funding for utilities to accommodate SHA updated programmed project expenditures and project schedules in FY 2023-2026. This modification also reflects the addition of \$23,973,600 in funds for the construction phase. The project's total cost, as documented in the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP, is increasing by \$24,973,000 from \$251,032,000 to \$276,005,600.

MD 197 Highway Reconstruction (T4887) – This requested administrative modification reflects the addition of \$273,000 in FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP project planning funding to accommodate SHA updated programmed project expenditures and project schedules in FY 2023-2026. This modification also reflects the addition of \$828,000 in funds for the preliminary engineering phase. This modification also reflects the reduction of \$1,113,000 in funds for the preliminary engineering phase. The project's total cost, as documented in the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP, is increasing by \$221,000 from \$6,737,000 to \$6,958,000, which includes funding programmed in years prior to and beyond the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP.

Riverdale Road Anacostia River Branch Bridge Replacement (T6647) – This requested administrative modification reflects the addition of \$667,000 in FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP funding for the preliminary engineering phase to accommodate SHA updated programmed project expenditures and project schedules in FY 2023-2026. This modification also reflects the reduction of \$8,313,000 in funds for the construction phase. The project's total cost, as documented in the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP, is increasing by \$639,000 from \$9,497,000 to \$10,136,000, which includes funding programmed in years prior to and beyond the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP.

I-95/I-495 Interchange at Medical Center Drive (T11578) – This requested administrative modification reflects the addition of \$2,100,000 in FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP funding for the preliminary engineering phase to accommodate SHA updated programmed project expenditures and project schedules in FY 2023-2026. This modification also reflects the reduction of \$3,000 in funds for the preliminary engineering phase. This modification also reflects the addition of \$400,000 in funds for the right-of-way phase. The project's total cost, as documented in the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP, is increasing by \$2,484,000 from \$84,451,000 to \$86,935,000, which includes funding programmed in years prior to and beyond the FY 2023-2026 TPB TIP.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report documents MDOT's requested modification with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The modified funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2025-2030 Consolidated Transportation Program (https://www.mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=27) and FY 2025-2028 Maryland STIP (https://www.mdot.maryland.gov/tso/pages/Index.aspx?PageId=117).
