This letter is to inform you that the C-SMMPO approves the administrative modifications to Areawide Environmental Projects and Areawide Safety & Spot Projects in the Calvert - St. Mary's Metropolitan Planning Organization's FY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) as revised.

The first modification is to the Areawide Environmental Projects (A-2024-01), to increase PE funding type by \$1.25 million in FY 25 and FY 26, totaling \$2.5 million. The total project cost is \$11.8 million, which will cover ongoing programming to provide environmental and aesthetic improvements on state highways. The non-capacity improvements may include noise abatement, wetlands, reforestation, landscape planting, scenic beautification, and pedestrian or bicycle facilities.

The second modification is to the Areawide Safety & Spot Projects (A-2024-02), to increase PE funding type by \$1 million in FY 25, FY 26, and FY 27, totaling \$3 million. The total project cost is \$18.2 million, which will cover ongoing programming to provide localized improvements to address safety and/or operational issues on state highways. These are highway improvements which may include but are not limited to projects dealing with bypass lanes, acceleration and deceleration lanes, turn lanes, rail crossings, intersection realignment, geometric improvements, safety improvements including bridge, bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements, pavement markers, ADA improvements, guardrails and roundabouts.

The information provided regarding the changes proposed is in order and necessary by MDOT and is subsequently endorsed by the C-SMMPO. The proposed changes will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the TIP, which continue to be fiscally constrained.

PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT OPPPD request C-SMMPO staff approve the following TIP administrative modification and, upon C-SMMPO approval, notify the FHWA Maryland Division of this administrative modification.

SUMMARY

The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) hereby requests C-SMMPO administratively modify the FY 25-28 C-SMMPO TIP to reflect the following two actions.

ANALYSIS

Areawide Environmental Projects (C-SMMPO A-2024-01) – This administrative modification reflects the addition of \$2,500,000 to FY 2025-2028 C-SMMPO TIP design funding for C-SMMPO A2024-01 with \$1.25 million in design funding added to both FY 25 and FY 26. This modification ensures the FY 2025-2028 C-SMMPO TIP reflects SHA's updated programmed project expenditures and project schedule in FY 2025-2028. This project's total cost is increasing from \$9.3 million to \$11.8 million. Per the October 29, 2014 memorandum of understanding executed by MDOT and the FHWA, this action is eligible to be processed as an administrative modification as C-SMMPO A-2024-01, is a \$10 million-plus project and this action constitutes an increase in total funding no greater than 20 percent of existing total project cost.

Areawide Safety & Spot Projects (C-SMMPO A-2024-02) – This modification reflects the addition of \$3,000,000 to FY 2025-2028 C-SMMPO TIP design funding for C-SMMPO A-2024-02 with \$1.5 million being added to engineering for both FY 25 and FY 26. This modification ensures the FY 2025-2028 C-SMMPO TIP reflects SHA's updated programmed project expenditures and project schedule in FY 2025-2028. This project's total cost is increasing from \$15.2 million to \$18.2 million. Per the October 29, 2014 memorandum of understanding executed by MDOT and the FHWA, this action is eligible to be processed as an administrative modification as C-SMMPO A-2024-, is a \$10 million-plus project and this action constitutes an increase in total funding no greater than 20 percent of existing total project cost

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) report document MDOT's requested modification with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The modified funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. MDOT published funding details in the FY 2025-2030 Consolidated Transportation Program (https://mdot.maryland.gov/tso/Pages/Index.aspx?PageId=27) and FY 2025-2028 Maryland STIP (https://www.mdot.maryland.gov/OPCP/FY 25-28 Final STIP.pdf).
