## **PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM**

To request the MDOT OPPPD, notify the Federal Highway Administration - Maryland Division of this amendment to add a new project to the FY 2025-2028 STIP.

### **SUMMARY**

#### **ANALYSIS**

MD 231 at MD 504 Geometric Improvements (CA2761) - This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project, and the addition of \$922,000 to preliminary engineering, \$444,000 for right-of-way, \$3,864,000 for utilities, and \$2,467,000 for construction for CA2761 in the FY 2025-2028 STIP. This amendment ensures the FY 2025-2028 STIP reflects the Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) updated programmed expenditures and project schedule in FY 2025-2028. This project's total cost, including funding programmed in fiscal years prior to and subsequent to the FY 2025-2028 STIP, is estimated to be \$14.6 million.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2025-2030 Consolidated Transportation Program and FY 2025-2028 Maryland STIP.
