## **PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM**

To request the MDOT OPPPD notify the Federal Highway Administration - Maryland Division of this amendment.

### **SUMMARY**

#### **ANALYSIS**

MD 51 Old Town Road Bridge Replacement (AL2321) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of \$127,064 to right of way for AL2321 for FY 26, FY 27, and FY 28. This amendment ensures the FY 2025-2028 STIP reflects SHA's updated programmed expenditures and project schedule. This project's total cost, including funding programmed in fiscal years prior to, and subsequent to, the FY 2025-2028 STIP, is estimated to be \$12.9 million. Design is underway and will proceed through Spring 2026. Construction is anticipated to begin in Winter 2025/2026 and proceed through Winter 2026/2027.

The attached STIP report documents MDOT's requested modification with respect to funding for the above project. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2025-2030 Consolidated Transportation Program
