ANALYSIS

MD 413 Trail from Marion Station to Westover (SO1944) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of \$710,000 for this project. The current total funding amount of \$19,994,000, as shown in the FY 2025-FY 2028 STIP, is incorrect. The corrected total for FY 2025-FY 2028 is \$19,294,000 and is reflected in the attached STIP report. Add \$266,000 in Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) funding to the preliminary engineering phase for FY 2026. Add \$356,000 in CRP funding to the preliminary engineering phase for FY 2027. Add \$88,000 in CRP funding to the preliminary engineering phase for FY 2028. This amendment will increase the total project cost from \$20,937,000 to \$21,647,000, which includes funds spent prior to FY2025. This project completes a 12-mile trail from Crisfield to Westover, providing a safe alternative for pedestrians and cyclists and supporting tourism and economic development opportunities. The improvements will also afford pedestrians and cyclists a safer alternative to navigate the corridor versus using the shoulder areas along the high-speed MD 413 corridor.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the FY 2025-2030 Consolidated Transportation Program and FY 2025-2028 Maryland STIP.
