WHEREAS, the Maryland Transit Administration (MDOT MTA) has requested approval of one amendment to the 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program through the approved Transportation Improvement Program amendment process; and

WHEREAS, MDOT MTA is requesting to amend the Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities project.
