## **ANALYSIS**

*I-68:* Cumberland Viaduct (AL6261) – This requested amendment reflects the amendment of a current project (AL6211) with a new project number (AL6261) and \$2,000,000 in planning funding. This amendment ensures the FY 2025-2028 STIP reflects SHA's updated programmed expenditures and project schedule in FY 2025-2028. Funding for planning is anticipated to go through FY 2027. The project's total cost is estimated to be \$2,000,000 with subsequent design and construction to be conducted under AL6211.

The attached STIP reports document MDOT's requested modification with respect to funding for the above projects. These requested actions will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates.
