PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

ANALYSIS

Railroad Crossing Improvements (AZ4441) – This requested amendment reflects the addition of a new project to the FY 2025-2028 Maryland STIP Railroad Crossing Improvements (AZ4441) with \$46,461 in planning funding. Included funding will be used for a data collection pilot at three railroad crossing sites. Data collection and improvement construction subsequently will take place at approximately 90 sites statewide. This amendment ensures the FY 2025-2028 STIP reflects SHA's updated programmed expenditures and project schedule in FY 2025-2028.

The attached Statewide TIP (STIP) reports document MDOT's requested amendment with respect to funding for the above projects. This requested action will not impact scheduling or funding availability for other projects in the current STIP, which remains fiscally constrained. The amended funding does not affect the portion of federal funding programmed for transit or allocations of state aid to local jurisdictions in lieu of federal aid.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the draft FY 2026-2031 Consolidated Transportation Program
