PURPOSE OF MEMORANDUM

To request the MDOT OPPPD, notify the Federal Highway Administration - Maryland Division of this amendment to modify the following project in the FY 2025-2028 STIP.

ANALYSIS

The National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Program – This requested amendment reflects the addition of \$289,000 in funding for design and \$17,932,000 in funding for construction in the FY 2025-2028 STIP. The project name and STIP number have been revised for clarity, to reflect that this project encompasses design and construction funding for NEVI Rounds 1, 2, and 3.

Design cash flows were adjusted to reflect the addition of funding in the amount of \$289,000 within the FY 2025-2028 STIP, and \$247,000 already spent funding prior to FY 2025, which was included in the previous FY 2022-FY2025 STIP. Design cash flows were further adjusted to reflect 80 percent NEVI funding and a match of 15 percent Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds (converted via toll credits), and 5 percent state contribution.

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Construction cash flows were adjusted to reflect the addition of \$15,482,000 in the FY 2025-2028 STIP, which was included in the previous FY 2022-FY 2025 STIP. Additionally, \$2,450,000 in construction funding is being added. Construction includes 80 percent NEVI funding and 20 percent private funding through the Contractor. Construction is anticipated to begin in Spring 2026 and is anticipated to be completed in Spring/Summer 2033. The total project cost is estimated to be \$25,087,000 for the rural regions of Maryland, which includes \$4,602,000 in construction funding beyond FY 2028.

In addition, the Maryland Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) remains fiscally constrained. The TTF supports State transportation system operation and maintenance, MDOT administration, debt service, and capital projects. Semiannually, MDOT updates revenues and expenditures using two national forecasting companies' latest economic estimates. The MDOT published funding details in the draft FY 2026-2031 Consolidated Transportation Program and FY 2025-2028 Maryland STIP.
